5) Charts

- Charts and chart types.
- Creating, using and formatting charts.

6) Sections, breaks and orders

- Grouping data in a section.
- Using breaks to group data in tables.
- Using orders to organise sections and data in tables.

7) Filtering values displayed in a report

- Working with reports' filters.
- Applying several filters in a report.

PARTICIPANTS

End users in charge of writing the reports; people involved in Decision making.

PREREQUISITES

Knowledge of desktop applications such as Excel. The knowledge of decisional environments is an asset.

TRAINER QUALIFICATIONS

The experts leading the training are specialists in the covered subjects.
