1) InDesign: the key to professional page layout

- Notions of page layout. Interface and workspace.
- Ruler guides. Customizing the menus.

Hands-on work: Discover the interface and create personalized spaces.

2) Blocks.

- Types of frames. Entering and importing texts.
- Lettering, typographic lines, tabs, bullets and numbering. Vectorization of text.
- Inserting images. Adding text to an object.

Hands-on work: Create a two-page leaflet.

3) Paper and digital publishing

- Gathering linked files. Color separation and four-color process configuration.
- Export to other formats.
- Adapting a PDF for the Web. Export to XHTML.

Hands-on work: Create a PDF for the Web.

4) Photoshop: Image editing and photomontage

- Introduction to Photoshop. Colorimetry.
- The digital image. Resolutions and image sizes.
- Selection: lasso, magic wand, select color range. Layers.

Hands-on work: Create a photomontage.

5) Creation, touch-up and correction

- Drawing and touch-up tools.
- Transformations, symmetry, rotation.
- Brightness and contrast settings.
- Color corrections.

Hands-on work: Restore an old photo.

6) Illustrator: Vector illustration, the essential complement to pixels

- Difference between vectors and pixels.
- Principles of vector drawing and characteristics of an Illustrator document.

TRAINER QUALIFICATIONS

The experts leading the training are specialists in the covered subjects. They have been approved by our instructional teams for both their professional knowledge and their teaching ability, for each course they teach. They have at least five to ten years of experience in their field and hold (or have held) decision-making positions in companies.
